

Maximizing uptime on your Coca-Cola Freestyle dispenser

Cleaning the nozzle and injector ring

The nozzle and injector ring are singular components on the Coca-Cola Freestyle. It is crucial that both parts are properly cleaned on a daily basis.

Important!

Daily cleaning ensures:

Best quality beverage | Reduced false sold outs | Increased dispenser uptime

On a DAILY basis, or immediately when a clog occurs:

- 1

Using a clean cloth, twist nozzle to remove. (Turn counter-clockwise)



- 2

Scrub the nozzle with sanitizer solution and nozzle brush, then rinse in warm, clean water.



- 3

Soak nozzle in sanitizer solution for two minutes. (1 oz. Kay-5 packet per 2.5 gallons of water).



- 4

Using sanitizer solution and brush, scrub the injector ring and area around the nozzle. Get the bristles in the small pinhole openings to remove any clogs. This is where the syrups are dispensed.



- 5

Use a clean cloth to screw the nozzle back into its housing. (Turn clockwise)

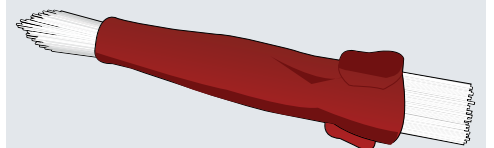
