



DAILY CLEANING & SANITIZATION PROCEDURES

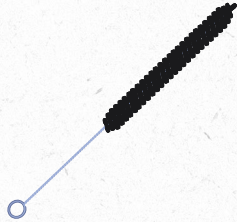
TOOLS YOU WILL NEED:



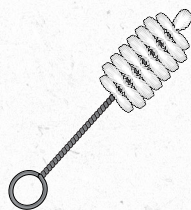
3 gallon bucket



Approved Sanitizer



Nozzle Brush



Valve Brush



Clean Cloths



Ice Chute Brush



Empty Spray Bottle



IMPORTANT DO NOT run nozzles, drip pan or other small parts through a dishwasher and DO NOT USE HOT WATER or BLEACH.

Cleaning the Dispensing Valves



IMPORTANT turn the key to the **OFF** position before cleaning the dispensing valves.



1 Wash hands with soap and water



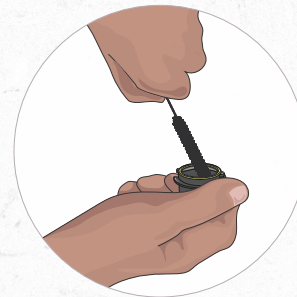
2 Prepare approved sanitizer in 3 gallon bucket



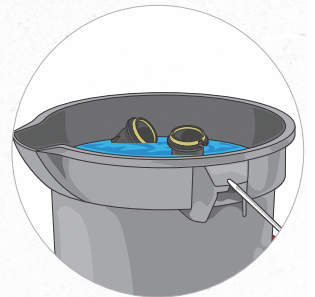
3 Fill empty spray bottle with sanitizer from bucket



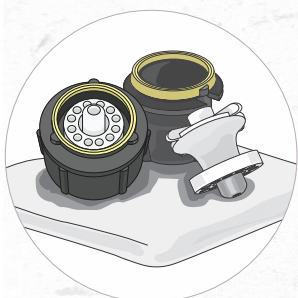
4 Remove nozzles/diffusers from dispenser valves



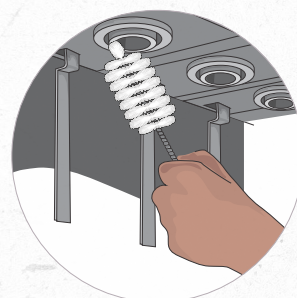
5 Clean in approved sanitizer with nozzle brush



6 Place in approved sanitizer for at least 3 minutes



7 Remove nozzles/diffusers from approved sanitizer and let air dry



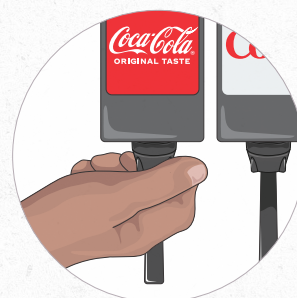
8 Spray and scrub each lower valve body and lever



9 Wipe the lower valve body and lever dry with a clean cloth



10 Wash hands with soap and water



11 Once dry, reinstall all nozzles and diffusers



12 Activate valves for 10 seconds and taste-test each drink

Cleaning the Drip Pan



1 Pour 1/2 gallon of approved sanitizer over cup rest and down the drip pan drain



2 Remove rack, wipe down the drip pan with a clean cloth and approved sanitizer

Cleaning the Exterior



1 Spray down surface of the dispenser (valves, levers, & sides)

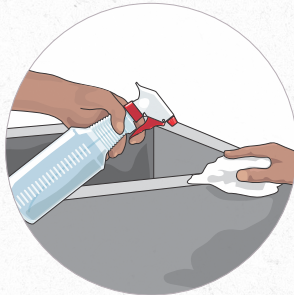


2 Wipe down all exterior components with a clean, dry cloth

Cleaning the Drop-In Ice Bin



1 Empty the ice bin, then pour 1/2 gallon approved sanitizer



2 Spray all interior surfaces with approved sanitizer and wipe dry with a clean cloth

Cleaning the Ice Combo Ice Chute



1 Dip the ice chute brush into bucket of approved sanitizer



2 Thoroughly clean ice chute with the ice chute brush
