Cleaning and Handling BIBs

Proper storage and handling of BIBs is crucial to keep drinks flowing.


MANAGING YOUR INVENTORY

- · Manage inventory by using the oldest sweetener box first. Check the label for date.
- Proper storage at comfortable room temperature helps ensure quality beverages.
- When storing BIBs, keep the arrow on the box pointing up.



CHECKING SWEETENER


- Check the remaining sweetener each day. The green dot will change to a red dot when sweetener is gone.
- All full calorie brands grayed out? Check your HFCS levels. All low/no cal brands grayed out? Check your NNS levels!







For 7000 and 7100, NNS may be a BIB under the counter, or it may be a cartridge that is placed like other ingredient cartridges. If so, they will always be in the number one (1) or top slot in the cartridge shelf.

REPLACING HFCS AND NNS BIB


Double check to see how much product is left by lifting the box.



Use a cloth to catch any spills, and turn connector counterclockwise to loosen.



Remove connector and replace with new **HFCS** sweetner BIB.



NOTE: Always check product is within the Enjoy By Date.

Scrub using the blunt end of the nozzle brush and soak in approved sanitizer



Wait two minutes, repeat with clean sanitizer and air dry.




Helpful hints: Understanding HFCS and NNS

HFCS (High Fructose Corn Sweetener)

- Used for all full-calorie beverages
- HFCS comes in 5.0 gal BIB (same size as current BIB) and is identical to changing other BIB syrup boxes
- HFCS shelf life 120 days

NNS (Non-Nutritive Sweetener)

- NNS comes in 2.5 gal BIB (same size as current 2.5 gal BIB) or as a cartridge
- NNS BIB shelf Life 75 days



DO NOT use a sharp object to open.



Attach the connector to the fitment and turn clockwise to tighten.
