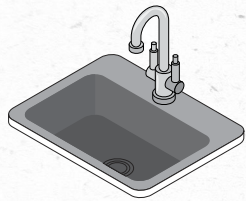


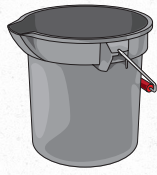


BUBBLER CLEANING & SANITIZATION PROCEDURES

TOOLS YOU WILL NEED:



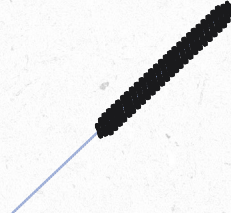
Sink



Clean 3 Gallon Bucket



Approved Sanitizer



Nozzle Brush



Clean Cloths



Clean Empty Spray Bottle

! IMPORTANT: DO NOT run nozzles, drip pan or other small parts through a dishwasher and DO NOT USE HOT WATER or BLEACH.

Daily Cleaning components



1 Follow disassembly instructions prior to cleaning.



2 Wash hands with soap and water.



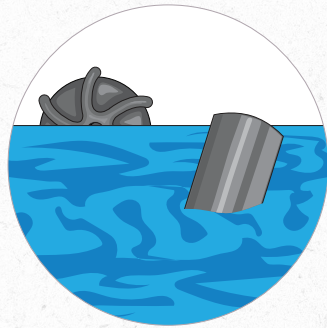
3 Prepare approved sanitizer in a 3 gallon bucket.



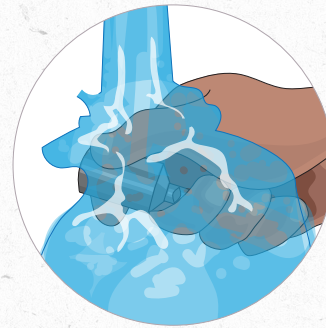
4 Prepare a spray bottle with approved sanitizer.



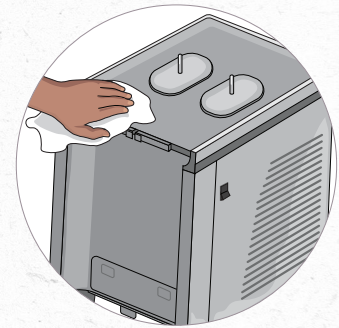
5 Place parts in sink to rinse.



6 Wash the small parts with soap and warm water in sink (not exceeding 50°C or 122°F).



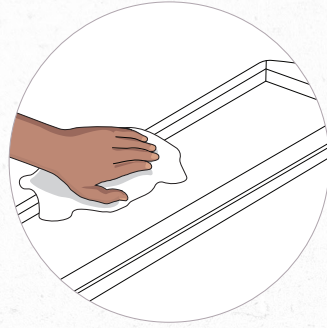
7 Rinse with clean water.



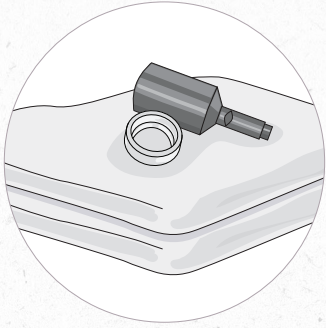
8 Clean front panel, exterior panels, release latch, and evaporator plates with spray bottle sanitizer solution and wipe with a clean cloth.



9 Clean counter and bottom part of dispenser with spray bottle sanitizer solution and wipe with a clean cloth.



10 Clean inside of bowl and lid with soap and water, and then rinse with clean water.

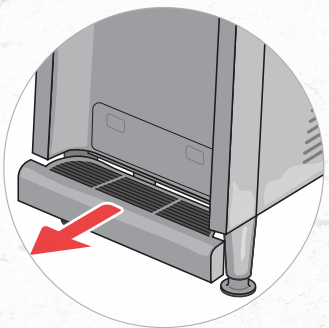


11 Allow all parts to air dry overnight.



12 Follow assembly instructions to resume production.

Weekly Cleaning the exterior



1 Remove tray and wash with warm water. Allow to air dry.



2 Remove filter from under the unit and rinse with water. Allow to air dry.
